



BVBN REPORT

I am very thankful that God has granted me the opportunity to serve the churches of the Brazos Valley. 2022 has been a year of transition and change. At last year's Annual Gathering, we voted to change our name and restructure the association with a new set of by-laws. This year we've begun to operate within this new structure, and it has allowed the work of the Network to be more streamlined and focused.

Our Network exists to glorify God through partnering, mobilizing, and strengthening churches to extend the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Here is a recap of what our Network has done in each of those three areas in 2022:

Partnering: With help from our partnership team, the Network provided several training workshops this year on the following topics: Becoming a Multiplier, Building a Healthy Team Culture, Deacon Training, Guiding Effective Corporate Prayer, Peacemaking in the Church, and Evangelism. Another workshop entitled How to Start a Young Adult and College Ministry will take two weeks from today. We also provided ministry luncheons for worship, youth, college, and children's leaders. In April, we had a Pastor & Wife Date Night; in one week, we will have another Pastor & Wife Fellowship. We continued our monthly Coffee & Conversation meetings, consistently generating edifying discussion and fellowship.

Mobilizing: Our mobilization efforts included financially supporting a new Hispanic church plant in Anderson, TX, and helping get another Hispanic church plant going in Millican, TX. The Mobilization Team is helping us revamp our Church Health Cohort as we prepare to re-launch it in January 2024. Many of our Hispanic 2022 CHC graduates participated in and graduated from an intensive six-month-long follow-up preaching course. I had the opportunity to return to Honduras for the first time since before the pandemic and am examining ways to get more of our churches involved in the mission work I have been doing there.

Strengthening: It's exciting to see the vision of churches revitalizing and replanting other churches take hold in our Network. Our first successful assisted revitalization/replant saw Southern Oaks Baptist replanted by Emmanuel Baptist as Redeemer Baptist Church. We also saw Anderson Baptist partner with Nueva Vida to start a replanting/planting strategy that aims to revitalize dying churches while also planting new Hispanic churches. The first opportunity to see this strategy workout is happening right as Reid's Prairie Baptist Church is being replanted and a new Hispanic work is simultaneously being started in the same location. This is an exciting new work that you can be praying about. This year we took one of our churches through our new Pastor Search Training Program, and we have seen the process bearing good fruit in that church.

With all that God has allowed us to do, I know that there is still a need for the Network to grow and strengthen. Our Leadership Team is entering into a 12-month, gospel-driven, strategic planning process with the Reinolds Group called Prism. I look forward to re-imagining what our Network can and should be doing to serve our churches as they advance the gospel.

- The BSM's **Great Give Away** for international students allowed us to help 140 new students from 16 different countries. Some of these students are already involved in BSM weekly events and groups. Thirteen area churches partnered with us.
- We hosted six different **Howdy Week** outreach events to meet new students.
- Two students in our Viva (Hispanic) Ministry have become Christians this fall. One has already been baptized in a local Baptist church. Two Viva leaders will be part of a BSM Go Now mission trip to Mexico City in October. Viva hosts a Tuesday evening dinner and Bible study that is growing. Nine students lead this ministry.
- One of our students has begun a weekly Bible study and ministry with students from the Visualization
 (Animation) Department. This growing group meets weekly at the BSM. The Christians are finding
 great chances to share Christ with their classmates.
- We do five weekly **outreach tables** at A&M and Blinn College. We also do a weekly campus Bible table at A&M. These tables open the door for evangelism and involving students in Bible studies and other growth opportunities. We have given away many Bibles this fall.
- Time for Chai is a gathering for Indian students that we host with the Desi Aggies student organization. The first T4C attracted approximately 380 Indian students.
- Vision lunch is off to a great start. We are having over 250 students attend each. Almost half of these
 are international students and others who are not believers. Lunch opens the door for friendships and
 evangelism.
- We have 114 student leaders this fall.
- God has blessed Journey this fall. We have 16 different small groups. Over 40 students serve as leaders with **Journey**. We are excited to have a good group of new freshmen.
- Our BSM has two weekly English classes and four weekly community groups for international students. The response has been excellent with students from over 25 countries becoming involved in BSM. We have begun reading the Bible with students from several different countries who are not yet believers.
- We have established a new mission partnership with IMB missionaries in **Serbia**. A BSM team served in Belgrade after the spring semester. A second team will return in May.
- Our mission partnership in the Pacific Northwest continues to bear fruit. Aggies from our BSM now serve as campus ministers at the University of Oregon, Mt. Hood Community College and Washington State University in Vancouver. We will take a team to work on these campuses in January. Other recent grads are serving as BSM interns at Rice University, University of Houston and on campuses in Galveston.
- Our ministry at Blinn College in Bryan is going well. In addition to campus tables, we host a Monday lunch Bible study and an evening small group study. A healthy number of Blinn students are also involved in weekly ministries and discipleship at the Aggie BSM.
- Ministry with the Aggie Band and Corps of Cadets continues growing. We now have four student leaders who lead the Monday evening Bible studies on campus. The opportunities for evangelism and discipleship are great.
- We are working to reestablish ministry on the RELLIS campus this year. Two new interns joining our staff in January will be a great help with this ministry.

Accountant's Compilation Report

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Management has elected to omit substantially all the disclosures ordinarily included in financial statements prepared in accordance with the cash basis of accounting. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the Organization's financial position and change in net assets. Accordingly, the financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.
